You asked if the New Haven Bible Students believe that God, the Almighty, is a triune God as do many who claim to 'follow Christ'? You told us that you personally do not believe that God's son is the Almighty God. You do, however, listen to God's son (John 20:17). You stated that you are a non-denominational Christian desiring to help others see the importance of 'coming' to his first-born son of his Kingdom in order to drink of God's word, the waters of truth.

We are happy to inform you that 100% of the Bible Students have come to the conclusion that the Trinity doctrine is a misunderstanding and not accurate. We believe that God is the original supreme Creator and that Jesus is his perfect son.

Jesus was originally a perfect spirit being, but was willing to sacrifice that position and was born as a perfect man in Bethlehem, lived in Nazareth and died at Calvary. This death was a corresponding price (ransom) for the sin of Adam.

We feel that Jesus' faithful sacrifice allows all mankind to be resurrected from death eventually, and that God's Plan will bring the majority back to human perfection. (Some will choose not be obedient after the resurrection, but that will be a small minority.)
